1. Welcome

Emma Sinclair welcomed everyone, thanked them for attending and gave apologies for those listed above.

2. Confirmation of last monthly meeting's draft minutes

Catriona MacDonald proposed, and Steven Sinclair seconded.

3. Actions from previous meeting

- a. Poverty action survey- a draft survey had been drawn up but after discussions with members and the public it was decided not to go ahead with the project.

4. Financial Report

£3059.52 in the bank account. £751.63 paid out for insurance. £300 cheque cashed for grant to North Apex Gymnastics, £160 cheque cashed for grant to Thrumster Community Development Association. £115 cheque yet to be chased by Befrienders.

£305 left for microgrants if Thrumster Primary Parents Council need full £250.

~£80 for poppy wreaths to be paid soon.

Holly Forbes proposed, Emma Sinclair seconded.

5. Microgrant applications

5 full members present- quorate.

- a. Befrienders awarded £115- confirmation of e-vote.
- b. TCDA awarded £160- confirmation of e-vote.
- c. Newton hill woodlands- £420 requested, all voted yes to giving as much as we can
ACTION To follow up with Thrumster Parents to see what grant was needed and give surplus, if possible, to Newton hill.

6. Local issues

- a. Vandalism in Haster reported to Police, awaiting a call back for a report.

- b. Milton road safety- response from roads department: no knowledge of pedestrian crossing. Wood on the side of the new pavement is the finished product. **ACTION** Feedback to roads department that signage is needed to warn drivers of pedestrians crossing over the road to Milton.
- c. Insurance for park and community council was cheaper than originally quoted, started on 20th of October (price in financial report above).
- d. Haster park- evidence is nearly all gathered for the funds to be released and the equipment ordered.
- e. Friend of Newton Hill Woodland- xmas tree sale on 3rd and 4th of December. Need for additional layby highlighted again.
